The Annual Diwali Show this year will be held at Horseshoe Pavilion on Saturday, November 9th, 2024. Stage rehearsals will be on Friday, November 8th.

The program will start at 5 pm followed by dinner at 7pm. We will strictly adhere to the 2-hour duration for the program; therefore, please submit your items/ proposal to the cultural committee as soon as possible to ensure your place.

Please note the following guidelines for participating in Diwali cultural program:

- 1. Participants must be members of HAWT.
- 2. Who ever would like to choreograph for HAWT Diwali Cultural, please contact asap.
- 3. Choreographers are responsible to ensure membership status of the participants.
- 4. Choreographers have the final call on taking participants in their group; however, choreographers should not refuse any participant unless they have more than 10 participants.
- 5. Each dance/song item should be around 4 minutes.
- 6. Please have each child participate in only one item.
- 7. Age limit for participation is 5+ years.
- 8. No solo items. (May be considered unless otherwise needed; however, only at the discretion of cultural committee.)
- 9. Choreographers are requested to send a group photo of participants as well as an individual photo taken while they are practicing.
- 10. Music should be in a digital format and should send two weeks prior to the show time. (Consult Nanda Kesavan, nandak7@yahoo.com)
- 11. To avoid the duplication of same song being selected by two groups, please let us know the song once finalized.
- 12. Choreographers are requested to choose songs to highlight the cultural and ethnic diversity of India as much as possible along with appropriate costumes.
